WHEREAS square dancing takes place in many cities across British Columbia and Canada and helps relieve stress, develop flexibility, strength and coordination and

WHEREAS square dancing allows dancers to meet and enjoy the company of people from all walks of life, and

WHEREAS Our Lieutenant Governor, by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, has been pleased to enact Order in Council 903 on October 11, 2002;

NOW KNOW YE THAT We do by these presents proclaim and declare that the September 10 to 16, 2006, inclusive, shall be known as

“Square Dance Awareness Week”

in British Columbia.
