Standing Orders

Standing Order #1

B.O.D. Meeting April 5-6, 2003

M/S that the BCSRDF put a brief version (no longer than one page) of the Newsletter in each Square Dance Publication in the Province. All Newsletters and Minutes to be put on the Web Site and advertised 4x a year that it is there. Carried.

Standing Order #2

B.O.D. Meeting April 5-6, 2003

M/S that we consolidate the various Memorial Fund Accounts into a single Memorial Fund allowing us to use the interest for Caller/Cuer Leadership Training. Carried.

Standing Order #3

A.G.M. August 7, 2003

M/S that Membership Lists be created in compliance with the Societies Act of B.C. Lists will be kept confidential. Carried (Societies Act only requires that we keep a list of all Current Directors)

Standing Order #4

B.O.D. April 1, 2006

M/S that the Treasurer be authorized to move Funds, with the approval of the Executive, from one Institution to another in order to get a better rate of return on Investments. Carried.

Standing Order #5

A.G.M. August 10, 2006

M/S that we endorse the idea of relaxing the Dress Code. We are prepared to accept people at our functions neatly dressed and groomed. Carried.

Standing Order #6

B.O.D. March 31, 2007

M/S that the B.C. Federation support SD&RDA week to be held on the 3rd week of September of each year and that the B.C.S.& R.D.Federation Secretary approach the Government to arrange for a Proclamation for SD&RDA Week. Carried.

Standing Order #7

B.O.D. March 29, 2008

M/S that we accept the Logo and make it available for anyone to use. Carried. This Logo can be found on the B.C. Web Site.

Standing Order #8

B.O.D. April 6, 2013

M/S that we reduce the number of delegates to the Board of Directors Meetings to Four (4) per Region and that this be done for a Two(2) Year Trial Basis. Carried.

Standing Order #9

B.O.D. April 6, 2013

M/S that the delegates at the Board of Directors meetings be allowed to approve expenditures up to \$8,000.00 (up from the current limit of \$5,00.00). Carried.

Standing Order #10

B.O.D. April 6, 2013

M/S that the BCS&RDF engage in more Self Promotion through Submissions to the Valley Circle, cross Trail News and Similar Publications. Carried.

Standing Order #11

B.C.S.& R.D. F. A.G.M. August 5, 2016

M/S. that the BC Square and Round Dance Federation recognizes, understands and greatly appreciates the effort and initiative of Nick and Mary Anne Turner in creating the Moving and Grooving Programme but cannot approve the return of funds held by it and designated "Moving and Grooving" to them. The Treasurer is directed to maintain the Moving and Grooving funds as a dedicated account to be used only for the continued maintenance, development and upgrading of the Moving and Grooving Programme and recommends that an Imprest Account be established with Nick and Mary Anne Turner for routine and maintenance expenditures and that major expenditures, for example, digitizing the programme, be paid directly from the Moving and Grooving fund. Further, all monies received from the sale of the Moving and Grooving Programme shall continue to be forwarded to the Federation on a quarterly or half-yearly basis as shall be agreed between the Treasurer and Nick and Mary Anne Turner.
