Why come to the Bendigo National Convention in 2017?

Bendigo is a historic town with lots to offer tourists: The Central Deborah mine, Talking Tram, Waterworld, Imperial Joss House museum and of course, the famous Easter Parade. There are plenty of excellent restaurants and great shopping against a stunning heritage backdrop.

Bendigo is home to five dragons, including Loong, the world's oldest Chinese imperial dragon, and Sun Loong, the world's longest imperial dragon at more than 100 metres long, who comes out of hibernation every Easter to parade through Bendigo.

The venue for the Convention is Bendigo Stadium, recognized as one of the best venues of its type in regional Australia. It has indoor sprung wooden courts, air conditioning, a licensed bistro, crèche, plenty of seating, a canteen and ample parking.

The Bendigo Visitors Centre has access to over 90 Bendigo accommodation properties, bookable online. They will also organise your tour and event-bookings.
