

MUSIC LICENCE FORM - TARIFF 19 – FITNESS ACTIVITIES AND DANCE INSTRUCTION (dancercize, aerobics, body building etc.)

- Grants you permission to play (publicly perform) musical works in conjunction with fitness activities and dance instruction
- Annual fee is the annual average number of participants per week, multiplied by \$2.14 (minimum fee is \$64) + taxes for each room where music is played
- Deadline for SOCAN to receive forms and payments is January 31st of the year for which a licence is granted (except for first time reports)

Terms & Conditions

The legal terms that govern your licence include those set out herein as well as those found in the approved tariff including the General Provisions, as approved by the Copyright Board of Canada for each year (collectively, the “*tariff*”). If you have any questions regarding the terms, please [contact us](#).

1. In this form, *you*, *your* and *licensee* means the person or company applying for a licence or filing an annual report. *We*, *our*, *us* and *SOCAN* means the Society of Composers, Authors and Music Publishers of Canada. *Works* means any or all of the musical works in SOCAN’s repertoire.
2. A copy of any SOCAN tariff may be obtained by emailing licence@socan.ca or calling 1.866.944.6223.
3. If you are applying for a licence, SOCAN will process your application within 30 days of receipt and contact you in the event that your application is not approved. If you already have a licence under this tariff, this is your annual report.
4. If the tariff for a year has not been approved by January 1st of that year, the last approved tariff will govern until the new tariff is approved, at which time the licence fees will be adjusted to reflect the approved tariff for the year.
5. This licence will renew automatically on January 1st of the following year for a 12-month period unless terminated by either party upon 30 days notice in writing.
6. The licence fee, plus applicable taxes for the year, will be calculated in accordance with the terms of the tariff based on the information set out in the most recently filed report form or audit form, subject to adjustment to reflect any updated reports or audits pursuant to the tariff.
7. You will keep records of all information required to calculate the licence fees.
8. Licence fees and report forms are due no later than January 31st of the year covered by the licence or within 10 days of any adjustments.
