

Past President's Report for the B.O.D. Meeting of the B.C.S. & R.D.Federation
April 1, 2017

September 2016 we attended the Ocean Waves 27th Corn Roast in Courtney as well as Magic A2 weekend in Chase and both dances were well attended. While attending the National Festival in Regina we also attended the CSRDS A.G.M. and at that time were approached by the National Festival Committee and asked if it would be possible to hold a National Festival in B.C. in 2020 since by then it would be 20 years since B.C. had held one. Steve Edlund approached us regarding holding a Festival along the lines of a very successful Festival which had been put on by Regina. Steve had made some inquiries into a possible hotel that could accommodate such an event. We therefore contacted the F.V.S. & R.D.A. V.& D.C.T.A. and consulted the B.C.S. & R.D. Federation Executive and received the O.K. to go ahead with submitting a request to the CSRDS to hold Festival 2020 in B.C.. The National Executive were overjoyed and our request was granted. Since then much time and energy has been put into getting the machinery up and running. There will be more on this in the Festival 2020 Report.

I also got involved with F.V. in reviewing their ByLaws to be in accordance with the New B.C. Societies Act which was very time consuming.
