The remaining DVDs which now comprise our new condensed mobile library can be accessed by regional associations wishing to participate in our time sharing program by filling out the application which can be found on our Federation web site (under "DVD Library Catalogue") and submitting it electronically - or by downloading a copy, filling it out and sending it to me. So far, only one association has taken advantage of this offer, that being the Region 8 dancer's association.

I took part in the ROAR meeting held last fall in the Lower Mainland and was able to give a bit of an overview of the West Coast Pilot Program to the attendees as well as hear some of that region's concerns and possible solutions.

I approved the release of the grant money to clubs participating in the West Coast Pilot Program in late February once I could confirm that they were doing what was required of them. For those who may not know, participating clubs were required to advertise and take their turn hosting a sufficient number of West Coast level dances so that new dancers who graduated in December would be able to dance at that level at least once a week somewhere in the Region. This has been carried out to my satisfaction and I will have a more detailed report at the upcoming meeting.
