1st Vice Presidents Report to the BOD meeting March 28, 2015

This dancing year has been fairly quiet from the Vice President standpoint. In the last two months I have received 4 applications for new dancer funding and with the deadline for applications being March 1, 2015. The clubs applying for the \$250 funding are:

Country Cousins Square Dance Club – Victoria
Cowichan Cloverleafs Square Dance Club – Duncan
Westburn Wranglers Teen Club – Delta
Frontier Twirlers Square Dance Club – Victoria

I have also received an application for an Education and Leadership \$500 bursary from the Okanagan Square and Round Dance Association. This request is to offset the costs of putting on a caller's workshop, in Lake Country, on March 15, 2015.

As of 2014, funding requests for attending caller school are to be received by the 1st Vice President by March 1st in the calendar year in which the applicant will attend caller school. As of March 1, 2015 I have received two applications for funding. Both applicants are from Region 9. Both are for attending the Caller Workshop being held in Region 3 on March 15, 2015.

These funding requests are, at the time of writing, are being reviewed by the Funding Committee consisting of Al Ritchie, Bill Wood, Gord Ruedig and Norm Cox. At this time approval has been granted to the Okanagan Region for \$500, and to the members attending caller school. The other applications will be reviewed at the BOD.

On behalf of the Canadian Square and Round Dance Society and the BC Square and Round Dance Federation I have presented or will present a number of Recognition Certificates to callers and cuers and partners in Region 9.
