

Notices of Motion

I, Norman Cox, move that we look into the possibility of including East Coast Swing Dancing as part of our Square Dance Family so that they too could apply to the Canadian Society for 3rd Party Liability Insurance.

I, Norman Cox, move that former Dancers who are no longer Active Dancers but do come out to Club Dances to socialize and help with minor club duties be allowed to purchase 3rd Party Liability Insurance from the CSRDS without paying the B.C. Federation Fee.

Squareup BC Notices of Motion:

(2) MOTION: Whereas the Federation's domain name is a crucial, on-going resource in maintaining internet communications at various levels, it is moved that the domain "squaredance.bc.ca" be renewed for a 10-year term at the going rate or that term closest to it.

(3) MOTION: Whereas the policy set by an accepted motion at the April, 2015, BOD meeting to universally deduct 100 kilometres of travel allowance has been identified as contrary to good voluntary sector management, it is moved that it be struck down and the allowance be reinstated to apply to the full distance travelled with an upper limit cap, if a claim is duly submitted.

(4) MOTION: Whereas the Federation hosts on its website many of the web pages for its member clubs and the volunteers maintaining those pages, or interested in doing so, need to be able upgrade their skills, it is moved that one or more seminars be conducted in 2016 relative to the design, management and publishing of web pages. and

MOTION: In support of a motion to conduct a seminar in 2016 relative to the design, management and publishing of web pages, it is moved that the sum total of \$1500 be allotted to the project to cover possible expenses.

(5) MOTION: Whereas paid advertising of new dancer sessions and accessing free avenues of publicity can be fruitful in a strategic marketing approach, it is moved that regional associations be encouraged to host a day-long training seminar utilizing the expertise within the Federation's marketing initiative, SQUAREUPB.C.

(6) MOTION: Whereas it is essential that our membership understand the purpose and limitations of the B.C. Square and Round Dance Federation, it is moved that such information be reiterated at the start of every Federation meeting and posted in every newsletter or other official publication.

(7) MOTION: It is moved that a Fundraising Task Force be established under the supervision of the 1st Vice-President.

(9) MOTION: In consideration of the time-pressed nature of today's society and the desire of new dancers for condensed learning periods with less commitment, it is moved that the Federation encourage clubs to adopt square dance programs such as West Coast Square Dancing or the Callerlab Condensed Teaching Method and, furthermore, it is desired that multi-day dance events feature some dancing utilizing those programs.
