

**REGION 2 DELEGATES REPORT**  
**BCS&RDF Board of Directors Meeting**  
**April 7, 2018**

*2017 - 2018 Events and Happenings*

- Region 2 has a total of 639 dancers registered with 21 clubs, which 12 of these clubs hold New Dancer Classes. In total we are down a few dancers from last year, but up in January 2018 with approximately 39 New Dancers registered. We have 3 Round Dance clubs and 2 New Dancer/Mainstream clubs that dance in the daytime, and 7 New Dancer/Mainstream, 7 Plus clubs, 3 A2 clubs, 1 A1 club, 2 Teen clubs, 1 Wheelchair club, and 1 Alternating C1 and Plus Teach dancing in the evening.
- From January 2017 to December 2017 we have presented 19 Four Score and More Badges and 8 Four Score + 10 Badges to dancers who are still dancing.
- A very successful Festival 2017 was held on July 5<sup>th</sup> to July 8<sup>th</sup> in Cloverdale. The Committee are hard at work for Festival 2020 on July 29<sup>th</sup> to August 1<sup>st</sup> in Surrey, hosted by Fraser Valley Square & Round Dance Association and the Vancouver and District Caller Teacher Association. This is the 21st Canadian National Square & Round Dance Festival.
- The Promotion Committee are selling 5-year calendar at a cost of \$10.00 each.
- Wesburn Wranglers (Teen Club) celebrated their 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary on December 3, 2017.
- On January 19, 2018 Royal Swingers had a special celebration for Steve Edlund's 35 years of calling, complete with callers Kevin Thomaier and Steve Noseck from Washington State.
- In February, 2018 Betty and George Langtry received their 60 year pin and Gerry and Brian Catterall and Bert and Marilyn Koll received their 50 year pins.
- February 10, 2018 at the "Hearts and Roses" Gala with Don Moger calling and Cheryl Plume cueing, the Scroll of Honour was presented to Wendy Krueger caller/cuer and June Fitchett and Al Gibbs dancers.
- Heart and Stroke Benefit Dance sponsored by Town 'n' Country Dancers was held on February 18<sup>th</sup>.
- Zajac Ranch Benefit Dance sponsored by the Abbotsford Grand Squares was held on March 4<sup>th</sup>
