Rules made under Bylaw 10.1

1.0 Membership – Clubs and Associations

Clubs

- 1.1 The definition section of the BCSRDF Bylaws defines a club.
- 1.2 The organization referred to in the definition must include sufficient members to effectively carry out its purposes and it is the responsibility of the Association to which it belongs or applies to belong to satisfy itself that the club can satisfy this requirement. The decision of an Association made under this rule is binding on the BCSRDF.
- 1.3 An organization in a Region where there is no Association to which it can apply for recognition and which applies to the Board of the BCSRDF for admission as a club must satisfy the Board with respect to its ability to carry out its purposes.
- 1.4 All clubs which were members of the BCSRDF are as at 1st January 2019 shall be deemed to have met the foregoing requirements.
- 1.5 A club which fails to meet the above requirements ceases to be a member of the BCSRDF as of the date of such failure.

Associations

- 1.4 An Association of Clubs, Callers, Cuers or Leaders or a combination of any of these entities or persons , with an appropriate Constitution and Bylaws or similar governing documents, which exists in a Region and complies with the definition in the Bylaws shall be a member
