Rules made under Bylaw 10.1

3.0 Voting and Proxies

3.1 Every voting member is entitled to a single vote on every matter at a General Meeting requiring a vote of members.

3.2 A voting member shall exercise its voting rights by appointing a person as proxy using the form supplied for that purpose. (Attached below)

3.3 A proxy may represent one or more members and shall vote or abstain from voting as directed by each member. For example, a proxy appointed by 5 clubs could represent 5 differing positions , 3 in favour of a proposal or motion would be voted for the matter, 1 against would vote against and an abstention would not be voted.

3.4 It is in order for a member to authorise a proxy to vote at the proxy's discretion on any matter. In such circumstances, the member will be bound by the way such vote was exercised.

3.5 If a meeting should be adjourned without a matter to voted on being placed before it, the proxy remains valid for the adjourned meeting, but the member shall have the option to change their previous instructions and the proxy shall comply with such change..
