<u>GUIDELINES FOR APPLYING FOR FUNDING FOR NEW DANCER CLASSES</u> <u>Application Deadline: March 1 in the Current Calendar year</u>

- New Dancer Class Funding Grants may be applied for Once Every 2 Years. New Dancer Class funding grants
 will only be awarded up to the limit of the committee's budget. The Committee's Budget shall be approved
 Annually at the B.O.D. meeting. No One Grant shall exceed \$250.00.
- Applications must be sent to the current 1st Vice-President of the BCS&RDF. For the purposes of these
 criteria, the definition of a New Dancer Class will be "one that is at the introductory level of each dance form.
 Basic/Mainstream for Square Dancing, Phase II/III for Round Dancing."
- Funding for New Dancer Classes is intended for those clubs, callers and cuers who experience financial difficulties with their new dancer classes.
- It is expected that existing New Dancer Classes or Clubs will be receiving financial support from their parent/sponsoring club.
- Clubs, callers, cuers or leaders applying for this funding:
 - are required to be paid up members of BCS&RDF and are expected to encourage their new dancers to join the BCS&RDF as soon as is practical.
 - shall report any other funding that has been applied for, or received, for the new dancer class.
 - c. shall indicate whether or not new dancer classes are run in conjunction with a parent or sponsoring club dance time and whether or not these classes are sharing the cost of the hall rental and the caller's fees with this club.
- Applications will only be considered from classes which have been running for a minimum of 16 hours.
- 7. Applications will only be considered for one New Dancer Class per Parent Club in a Two Calendar year span.
- 8. With the exception of three free nights (Class leader's discretion) to introduce potential class members to the activity, the minimum fee will be \$5.00 per dancer, per night throughout the dance season. Method of payment is at the discretion of the hosting body of the class.
- Applications for New Dancer Funding Assistance are not retroactive. The requested assistance must be on behalf of the new dancer class enrolled during the current dancing season. Applications must be received no later than March 1 of the current Calendar year.
- 10. The amount for any one application will not exceed \$250.00 per Two year period to a maximum Budget of \$2.000.00 per year(Motion B.O.D Minutes April 15/14 P. 5) and applications will only be considered if the proper application forms and a list of the names of the New Dancers have been submitted. These forms can be copied from the Handbook or downloaded from the Federation Website (http://www.squaredance.bc.ca) or obtained from your regional delegate.
- 11. The granting of Federation funding for a new dancer class will be decided by the 1st Vice President and the Committee appointed for this task. The decisions regarding the granting of grants and the amount of the grant will be made by the committee after March 1st and payment made to successful applicant(s) made by March 31st to allow proper reporting at the B.O. D. Meeting and the inclusion in the minutes thereof.
- 12. Clubs, callers, cuers or leaders receiving funding shall forward, by November of the following season, a year end report to the current 1st Vice President of the BCS&RDF which shall include revenue and expenses, including grants, for the new dancer class as well as the number of dancers who graduated at the end of the year. Failure to do so will disqualify future applications.
