Since the last AGM, I have been working with the Constitution and By-laws Committee on the process of tidying up Policies and Procedures to comply with our legal documents. In particular, this avoids having to regularly file or refile documents with the Registrar.

I was pleased to be able to play a role in the committee headed by Dr. Blair Wallace preparing the Plan for a Plan to restart dancing.

Within the next 4 weeks, the application form for clubs seeking to take advantage of the \$500 Restart Grant will be on the website. The conditions for applying for the grant will include that a club has its own Restart Plan in place which complies, at a minimum, with mandated requirements: that the plan is acceptable to the hall or other location where the club dances and, very importantly, that the plan of the hall or location itself is acceptable to the club and can be complied with.
