Annual General Meeting – April 25, 2021

Report – Region 1 – Lower Vancouver Island Western Square & Round Dance Association

Region 1 – Lower Vancouver Island – is operating under the current COVID-19 realities with no in-person dancing but staying in contact with our members. Some dancers are taking advantage of virtual dancing offered on the Internet.

Our member clubs have all renewed their Association and Federation memberships for the 2020-2021 season: five Mainstream clubs, one Plus/Advanced club, and two round dance clubs, plus one new dancer group.

Even with dancing shut down we can report that 97 dancers renewed their individual memberships for 2020-2021. This compares to a dancer count for 2019-2020 of 250 made up of 194 graduate dancers and 56 new dancers.

We continue to hold meetings of the Association – a delayed 2020 AGM in October 2020, a general meeting in January 2021, and our 2021 AGM on April 18, 2021 – all using Zoom courtesy of the BCSRDF.

Our official magazine, the Cross Trail News, has suspended publication until public health orders are relaxed and dancing resumes.
