Note the clubs could apply for more than one grant

We have reviewed a total of 10 clubs applied (most for two grants) and 4 regional applications for this 2022/2023 season

Some were very straight forward, some needed alot of consideration, not all were approved, and some were approved with conditions to be met, and a couple that came in days before the deadline have been approved by the committee but not confirmed by the board or passed over to Pat for payout

Your committee approved

Three regional grants of 5000.00 each 15,000.00

Club grants for class advertising restart of  $500.00 \times 7 = 3,500.00$ 

Club grants for new dancer class start ups of  $500.00 \times 1 = 500.00$ 

Club grants for the 2 year bursary of  $250.00 \times 5 = 1,250.00$ 

A total of 20,750.00 grant money paid out for this season 2022/2023
